Pros of having hang from table cloth include great visual from afar, con - not stable if people are standing in front of it and difficult to see all the sample squares, laying banner on top of table pro- good visuals to seeing all the different sample squares, cons, not visible from afar. Other suggested being able to change display options for when there is a wall to hang banner from. This could utilize the rod system as well. Elaine as fair Liaison has volunteered to house the banner and will bring it to the next meeting for display discussions. Members want to note who has the banner so we do not lose it. Christine will send Phyllis the check for her work finishing the banner.
- Beth and Christine attended Stitches West in Sacramento and shared their experiences. They both enjoyed it. They mentioned it was smaller and some booths were empty likely due to excessive snow this year caused transportation problems. Classes seemed to be expanding from knit to sewing and other fiber arts.
